

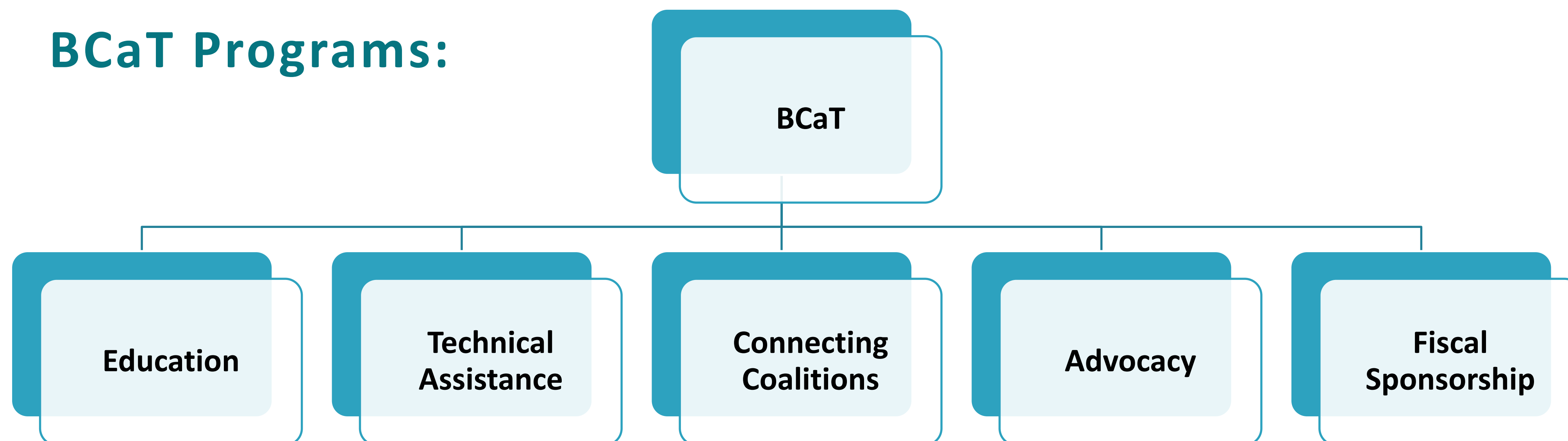

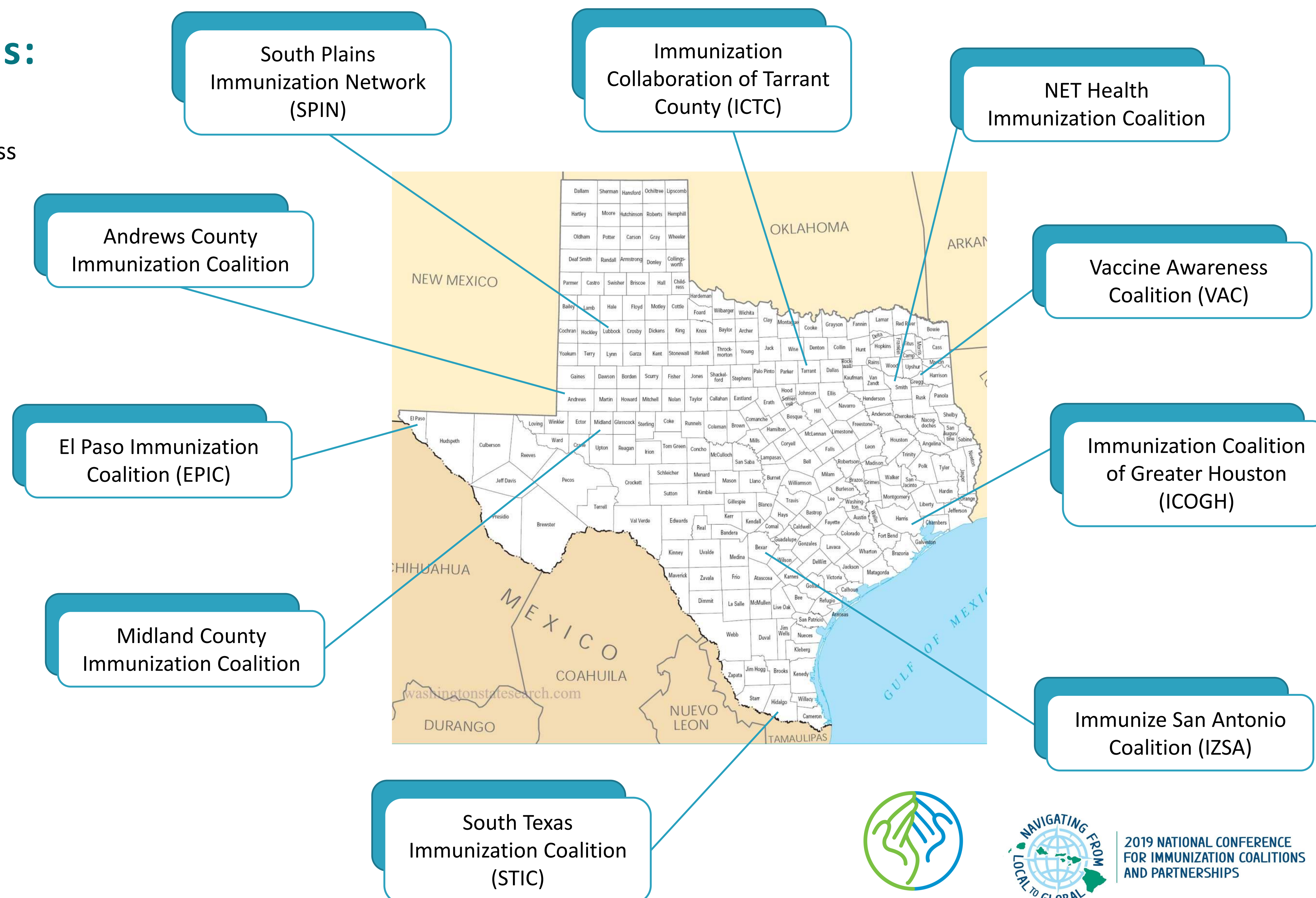

### Program Accomplishments:

Since 2011, The Immunization Partnership has partnered with immunization coalitions all across Texas to accomplish the following:

- 14 total coalitions (10 active currently)
- Helped form 2 new coalitions
- Helped re-establish 3 coalitions
- Developed 3 Coalition Toolkits
  - A Dose of Change: Building Capacity in Your Immunization Coalition
  - A Booster Dose of Communications Strategies
  - Event Planning for Immunization Coalitions
- Conducted 10 workshops on various sustainability and coalition growth topics
- Presented 30 webinars on immunization issues
- Created an online peer and resource network to connect coalitions
- Coalition members participated in 5 Texas legislative sessions
