#### **ANNUAL TEXAS IMPACT**

- Loss of \$26,442,970
- Loss of 631 public health jobs
- Loss of \$4,195,910 for low-income children and adult vaccine programs
- > Loss of \$6,166,855 to DSHS for core needs
- Loss of \$998,540 for infectious disease prevention






#### TEXAS LEGISLATURE




- > 150 members of Texas House of Representatives

Foster child in care of DFPS no longer allowed to be immunized during medical exam, except for emergency tetanus

- > Floor amendment by Bill Zedler (R-TXH-96-Arlington) to H.B. 39 by Gene Wu (D-TXH-137-Houston)
  - Passed House
